Presenter: **Dr. Kristie Pretti-Frontczak** is a Professor in early childhood intervention at Kent State University (KSU). Kristie received her doctorate in early intervention from the University of Oregon and has extensive experience in preparing pre-service and in-service personnel in recommended practices for working with young children and their families. She directs the Early Childhood Intervention Specialist Program at KSU, where she is responsible for preparing pre-service teachers to work with children with disabilities from birth to age eight. Kristie frequently provides training and technical assistance to programs interested in the Assessment, Evaluation and Programming System (AEPS), Activity-Based Intervention (ABI), and creating legally defensible and meaningful individualized education plans (IEPs).

Program: In this session, we will investigate a tiered model of quality instruction to support all children including those with disabilities in blended programs. Participants will have the opportunity to discuss issues related to existing assessment practices; learn about eight standards for professional "best practices"; and learn how to create multiple and varied embedded learning opportunities across daily routines and activities. The session will also focus on prioritizing needs, evidence-based instructional strategies, and data-driven decision-making procedures.
