Our Speaker: Dr. Donna S. Wayner is President and CEO of Hear Again, Inc. and the former Director of The Hearing Center at the Albany Medical Center Hospital, Albany, New York. She has served as an Associate Clinical Professor of Surgery at the Albany Medical College, Adjunct Professor at The College of Saint Rose and consultant to the Deafness Research Foundation and various organizations and agencies. Recognized in the field of hearing impairment and rehabilitation, Dr. Wayner has made numerous presentations at national and international conferences.

Our Program: This workshop discusses the basics of hearing loss, its implications upon the learner and the challenge it presents. Practical strategies for improving communication and understanding, promoting social integration and emotional well-being for students with hearing impairment will be reviewed. The basics of hearing loss, its types and causes and the relationship of hearing thresholds and the consequences for children will all be discussed. Participants will gain an increased awareness about the things that get in the way of the learning experiences of children with hearing impairment, and will become more informed about methods and strategies to improve the learning environment of children with hearing loss.
